Textiles = Clothes, Footwear, Linens, Stuffed Animals

- **Keep Textiles Out of the Trash!**
- Textiles should be donated for reuse.

Chicopee now offering two convenient ways to donate your unwanted clothes, footwear, linens, accessories, and stuffed animals:

## 1. TEXTILE BOX PROGRAM

Bring your unwanted textiles to any of the following municipal locations:

- DPW Office
- City Hall
- Senior Center (rear)
- Fire Station #3
- Fire Station #5
- Park & Rec Office
- Main Library
- Safety Complex (rear)
- Fire Station #4
- Fire Station #8



## 2. CURBSIDE TEXTILE COLLECTION "Pink Bag" Program

Place your unwanted textiles in pink bags at the curbside on your regular recycling pickup day.

## Acceptable Items for Textile Recovery

- **Clothing:** Sweaters, Sweatshirts, Dresses, Skirts, Pants, Jeans, Shorts, Socks, Shirts, Pajamas, Coats, Blazers, Undergarments
- **Footwear:** Shoes, Heels, Sandals, Work boots, Dress boots, Winter boots, Sneakers, Cleats, Slippers, Flip flops
- **Accessories:** Hats, Pocketbooks, Belts, Gloves, Book bags, Ties, Scarves, Backpacks, Bathrobes
- **Linens:** Sheets, Blankets, Curtains/Drapes, Aprons, Dish towels, Tablecloths, Comforters, Throw rugs, Pillows, Pillow cases
- **Stuffed Animals**

## Important Notes

- Textiles may be donated in any condition (stains/rips OK), but must be **clean and dry**.
- Textiles **MUST NOT** be placed in green recycling cart.
