LANDFILL DROP-OFF POLICY

For Free Drop-Off, Chicopee Residents
Must Pre-Register by calling
the DPW at 594-3566

In order to register you will need to give:

1. Name, address, phone of resident (who must own and accompany items)
2. Make, model & license plate of vehicle you will utilize

Resident's Use: Permit Expiration Date: LANDFILL CLOSURE

What you CAN bring: Some Fees may apply after limits reached

- **Household rubbish (limit 6 visits, yellow overflow bags accepted only)**
- Renovation (limit 2 pickup sized loads per year)
- Recycling (cans, bottles, mixed paper, cardboard) unlimited trips
- Scrap metal (unlimited visits, pickup sized load)
- Appliances containing freon (fridge, a/c, dehumidifier) limit 2 per year
- TV's/computer monitors (limit 2 per year); Small electronics unlimited
- Mattresses/Box springs (2 units per year) Foam mattresses are trash
- Propane tanks (limit 2 per year)
- Tires (\$1 per tire, \$3 on rim-limit 6) **CHECKS/CREDIT CARDS ONLY—NO CASH**
- Grass & leaves unlimited, Brush 3 inches by 3 ft. long max (limit 6 trips)

Limitations-Restrictions: DPW may revoke permit for breach of rules

- No items in commercial vehicles or U-Hauls: 3 cubic yard vehicles max
- No items in oversized trailers (double-axle, greater than 4' X 8' X 2 1/2')
- No more than 6 visits from date of issue (if so fee applies)
- No admission without pre-registering (see above) Picture ID required
- No hazardous materials, liquids, asphalt, brick, or concrete
- No items from residences other than your own/no permit transfers

NOTICE TO LANDFILL DROP-OFF USERS

Trash Reduction Program

BEGINNING MAY 1, 2017 AND FOR THE LIFE OF THE LANDFILL AND THE RESIDENTIAL DROP-OFF AREA (Scheduled to close June 29th 2019),

THE FOLLOWING DISPOSAL REQUIREMENT WILL APPLY TO ALL HOUSEHOLD TRASH:

****All loose or bagged household trash must be brought to the drop-off in official City of Chicopee yellow overflow trash bags to be accepted for disposal.**

Overflow trash bags are available in local retail stores. See DPW Website

Bulk Waste Advisory:

Bulk waste items not fitting into overflow bags (i.e., furniture, TVs, appliances, construction/demolition waste, mattresses) can still be brought to the landfill drop-off FOR FREE in 3-cubic yard, non-commercial vehicles until landfill closure. Pre-registration for a landfill permit from the DPW is still required for Chicopee residents to take advantage of this bulk drop-off privilege. Phone calls are encouraged.
